MAUNDY THURSDAY ~ April 12th SERVICE OF TENEBRAE & COMMUNION

Building on Palm Sunday, plan to take part in this meaningful Holy Week experience as the PCUM family focuses in its Maundy Thursday worship and the great love of God in Christ that sustains us through the darkest times and even to the cross.

The name 'MAUNDY' derives from the Latin word *mandatum*, which means "commandment," referring to Jesus' commandment to his disciples after washing their feet at the Last Supper: "For I have set you an example, that you should also do as I have done to you." (John13:15).

TENEBRÆ is the Latin word for darkness. During this experiential and narrative service, you will prepare to experience and understand Easter more fully by recounting the story of our Lord Jesus Christ's journey from the Last Supper to the Garden of Gethsemane, to Peter's denial and the trials before Pilate and Herod, and then to the cross. As Jesus' crucifixion approaches, lights in the sanctuary are progressively extinguished.
